VINTAGE 101

Denim companies try all sorts of washes and techniques, but they'll never precisely replicate the look of true vintage denim. A 75-year-old pair of jeans reflects the wear and tear of whoever rocked 'em, from unique patches to countless washings. These Cone jeans date from the 1930s, and though you can't buy them (unless you've got a few hundred thousand to spend on pants), they'll be inspiring the denim washes and patchwork on the jeans you wear for years to come.
