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[Dyneema](#) continues its ascent into the denim mainstream, and here to carry it to the forefront is... **Chrome Industries**? Most known for their brawny bicycle bags, Chrome introduces their **Wyatt Collection**.

Made using [Cone Mills](#) 12oz. (non-selvedged) denim woven with 8% Dyneema, it includes a pair of five pocket jeans, a work shirt, and a chore coat, all promised to outlast your regular all-cotton denim garments. Earlier this month, we saw some [brow-raising results](#) from *Saint*'s pair of Dyneema denim jeans showing us just how strong the stuff can be. Crotch blowouts may likely still be an issue, but the question is this: just how long will it take before they appear?
